Strayed, Missing or Stolen Livestock — Missouri

LMA has learned of 58 head of cattle missing from Baseline, Missouri, since August 29, 2011. There are 32 cows and 26 calves. They are Charolais and Charolais cross with the bull calves banded four days before they were missing. They all have a 3-notch cut in the left ear. They were not taken in pairs so they may be showing signs of separation distress. The day before cattle went missing two white males in a black-primer colored, late 1970s pickup truck were seen in the area.
